Care Plan

Electronic Medication Management

Keane NetSolutions offers an electronic medication management solution that:

- Maintains medication orders
- Charts order administration and vitals at point of care (eMAR/eTAR)
- Checks for adverse drug interactions
- Computerizes medication ordering and reordering

These functions are provided by Keane NetSolutions Physician Orders, Drug Interactions & Patient Education, eCharting, and ePrescribing (described below).

Physician Orders

Improves accuracy and efficiency in your facility's process for handling medication orders including data entry shortcuts, quick updates, order maintenance, and online telephone orders.

eCharting including eMAR and eTAR

Replaces paper Medication/Treatment Administration Records with a point-of-care system that alerts to late/missed deliveries, prompts to add notes, and connects to the network in real time with wireless technology. The eMAR is automatically updated with information entered in Physician Orders, reducing risk and eliminating the need for month-end turnover.

Drug Interactions and Patient Education

When an order is entered in Physician Orders, this software automatically screens for adverse reactions including drug-drug, drug-allergy, drug-disease, drug-food alerts, therapeutic duplication, and ingredient duplication.

Patient Education software provides medication information written for residents and their family.

ePrescribing

Streamlines medication ordering and eliminates trips to the fax machine. New medication orders are sent automatically to the resident's pharmacy by NCPDP SCRIPT message or by auto-fax according to the pharmacy's rules. Reorder a medication with a click that adds it to a list for review before sending to the appropriate pharmacy.

This charting system uses wall-mounted touchscreen devices at the point of care to encourage complete and accurate documentation of care delivered. CareTracker's interface with Keane NetSolutions imports vitals and totals for MDS Sections C (Mood), E (Behavior), G (ADLs), H (Continence), K (height, weight, weight loss), and O (Restorative Nursing).

Therapute is a complete system for managing therapy in LTC. It offers quick data entry for therapists, generates real-time management information reports, bills all therapy payors, supports paperless charting, and provides executive dashboards. Its optional interface with Keane NetSolutions exports therapy notes (using an SSL security certificate) and minutes of therapy to the MDS 3.0.
